Abstract: The Executive today approved the PlanCamino, which includes 28 measures in 5 lines of action to be implemented between 2022 and 2026, including the 1st Labor Insertion Plan for Victims of Trafficking, Sexual Exploitation and for Women in Prostitution Contexts.

The Social Work of Adorers in Spain, together with four other entities, will be in charge of developing the actions contemplated in this project, which includes psychosocial care, care for minors who are victims of trafficking and sexual exploitation, and job placement.

Luisa Puglisi, delegate of the Obra Social Adoratrices and director of the Amaranta Foundation, attends the presentation ceremony of the Plan together with the other entities.

- Actions will be carried out for socio-labour insertion and support for women victims of trafficking for the purpose of sexual exploitation, sexual exploitation and in contexts of prostitution in seven autonomous communities.
- It will do so within the Camino Plan that the Government has approved today with the aim of providing economic, labor and social alternatives to victims of trafficking and sexual exploitation, promoted by the Ministry of Equality, an organization that will promote specific and other transversal actions to be carried out with other ministries.

Abstract: We carry out individualized and interdisciplinary work with each woman since we consider that each case is unique and it is necessary to take into account the specific characteristics and circumstances of each of the women and their relationship with the environment. Through direct communication through interviews, group work or in the different dynamics of coexistence, a bond of trust is created, a context of mutual understanding and respect through which to establish the relationship of help that enables change and personal development. . To do this, the professional uses tools such as empathy, active listening and unconditional acceptance.

One of the basic pillars on which the project methodology is based, refers to the interdisciplinarity of the work, this concept implies the fact of facilitating and favoring spaces in which to integrate the contributions of the professionals involved, giving meaning and coherence to the actions performed. Interdisciplinarity also tries to promote coordinated and complementary teamwork at all times. This work system helps women to empower themselves in their lives and make a positive reading of events, as well as to put strength into the search for possible and positive solutions in the face of any difficulty.

Abstract: Yesterday we were participating together with representatives of APRAMP together with @fundacioncruzblanca and Deactivate trafficking of Diakonia Spain in a training course for European Union police officers organized by @guardiacivil062 specifically under the EMPACT project/initiative. In the round table we have shared our experience and real practical cases in relation to the collaboration we have between the security forces and specialized entities to detect, identify victims of trafficking and prosecute the crime. The training is focused above all on the prevention and approach to trafficking in human beings for the purpose of labor exploitation and we have shared experiences and examples of cases on this purpose of trafficking.

Abstract: On Friday we went to the United States Consulate to present the #TIPReport2022, the report that analyzes human trafficking in more than 180 countries, including Spain.

During the meeting, we coincided with other entities and institutions that, like us, fight against human trafficking in Catalonia and that, in addition, become informants of the TIP.

According to the report, in Spain, traffickers exploit foreign victims and, to a lesser extent, Spanish victims in state and foreign territory

The pandemic increased labor trafficking, especially in agriculture, domestic work and cannabis cultivation in Catalonia

Ukrainian refugees, especially women and children fleeing war, are vulnerable to human trafficking
