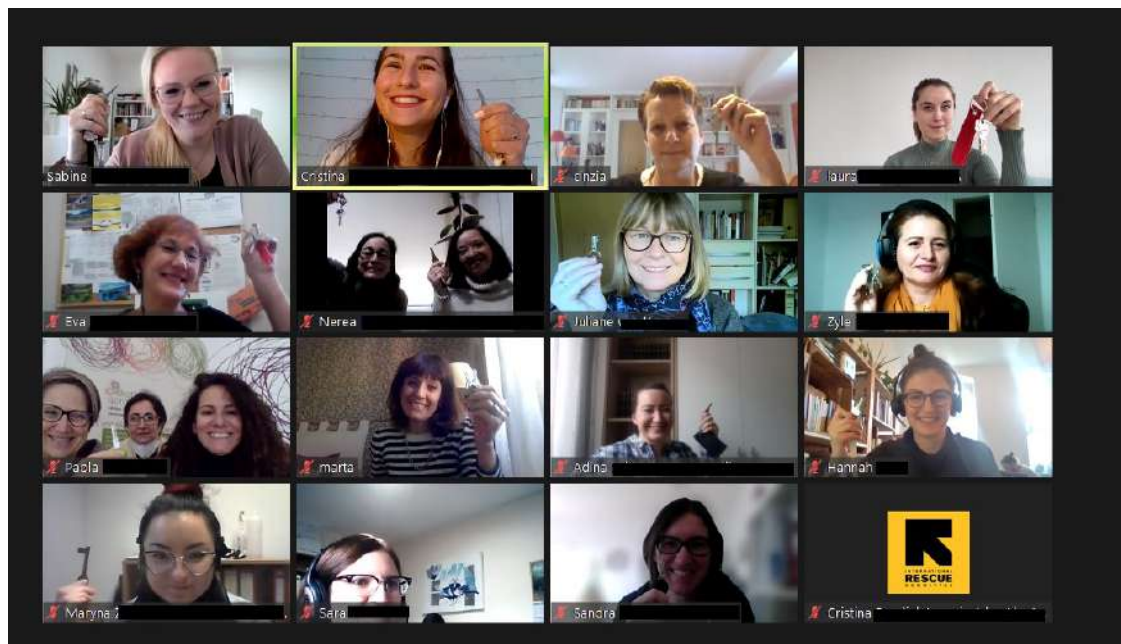

Abstract: The TATAS project (Transnational Initiative Against Trafficking in Human Beings in the Context of European Asylum Systems) was launched this Tuesday through a first meeting in which the entities that are part of the consortium that will implement the TATAS project. The consortium is formed by: ARSIS (Greece), Be Free (Italy), Dedalus (Italy) IRC (Germany), Proyecto Esperanza (Spain), SICAR cat (Spain) and STOP/Jadwiga (Germany). TIATAS is funded by the European Union and aims to strengthen practice and joint action in relation to the early identification and safe referral of victims of human trafficking, within the framework of the Asylum Mea Sures process, in accordance with EU standards. We hope that the project will improve access to rights for survivors of human trafficking.

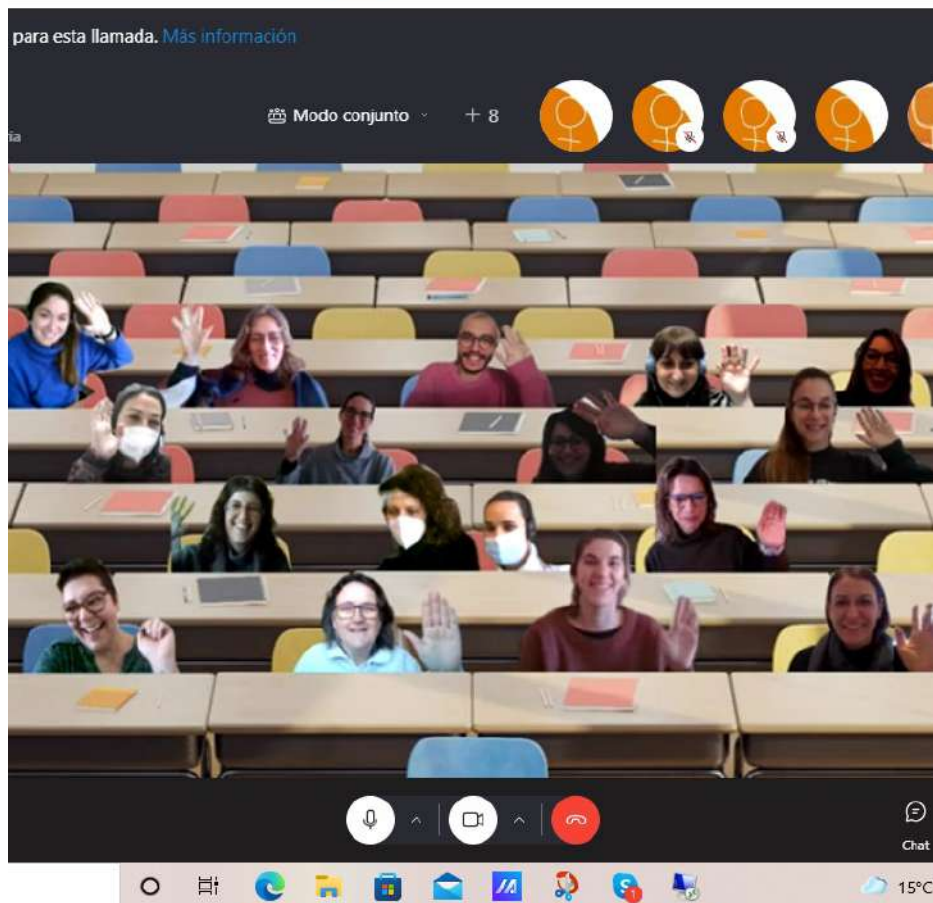

Abstract: Today we start the week with a focus on the role of the states. Human trafficking is a very serious violation of human rights and requires states to fulfil their responsibility and international obligations, giving primacy to the human rights of the victims, applying a gender-sensitive approach and acting with due diligence.

The duty of due diligence implies a positive obligation to protect actual or potential victims, as well as a procedural obligation to investigate trafficking and take measures to ensure that all trafficked persons are correctly identified and must always contain a specialization and added protection in cases of trafficking that also involve a form of gender-based violence. The State's obligations include taking measures to promote the full recovery (physical, emotional, psychological, and social) of trafficked persons, enhancing their right to adequate protection, assistance and redress, including effective compensation, with the necessary gender perspective and approach.

Abstract: Today we would like to bring you some testimonies from women who have been involved in the project over the last 22 years. One of the objectives in the intervention with victims is to make them feel respected to regain faith in the people around them. To generate that bond of trust that is key to their recovery after the trafficking experience.

- She has a special way of treating me, with affection, she is there. She listens to you, she listens to you, she makes you feel that she listens to you". Nigerian woman.
- I have felt like family here, this second family helps me to get ahead". Moldovan woman.
- We were all the same and of different colors". Ukrainian woman.
- Because they give you advice when I was nervous, when I was bad... I go to the office and talk to you, and you listen to me and tell me things, sometimes when... you make me laugh when I am sad, and when I am crying you tell me things that make me want to fight, no, you are always there to help me fight for what I want. And I see that as something very important for me". Nigerian woman.

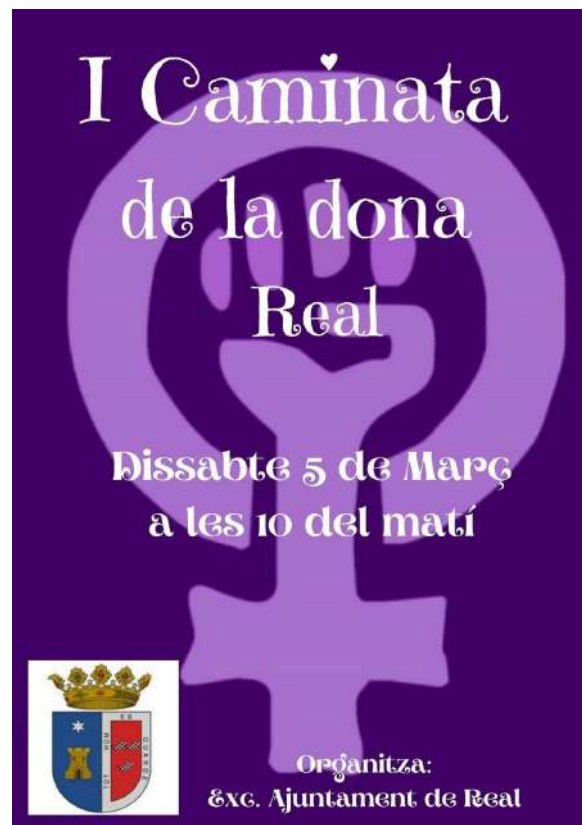

Title: Save the Children is concerned about the lack of protection for minors in care centers.

Abstract: In view of the cases of child sexual abuse and exploitation discovered in protection centers in different autonomous communities, Save the Children has expressed its concern about "this serious violation of rights" and insists that the priority must be the protection of the victims and their recovery. "Children and adolescents in protection centers are deprived of parental care, an extraordinary situation with emotional, affective and psychological consequences that makes them a particularly vulnerable group, with a greater risk of having their rights violated and being victims of violence, the most extreme expression of which is sexual exploitation. The protection system must ensure that the centers are safe environments and develop protocols for prevention and early detection of these situations as provided for by law," says Catalina Perazzo, director of social and political advocacy at Save the Children, in a press release.
